Greetings,

Many thanks for requesting an application form which is duly attached.

Please complete as appropriate and return it to the Membership Secretary at the address below. But first, please remember that you need to meet one of the General Committee so that they may give you a proper overview of what we can offer you and what support members are requested to give.

Once the form has been signed by you and a General Committee member and the membership fee has been paid you are a member; albeit a Temporary Member. The form is displayed on the notice board for two weeks and is then presented to the next General Committee meeting – meets monthly excluding August and December. Once it is been through the committee we write and confirm your full membership usually within a week or so of the committee meeting.

You are requested to make yourself aware of the Rules - see copy on the Notice Board or TSC website. All sailing members (social members optional) are requested to undertake two race box/ rescue boat duties a year; usually as an assistant until one has learnt the ropes.

All members are requested to join in the work parties; for usually two hours one day in the Spring and the same in the Autumn. This could be to help with cleaning windows to gardening or painting. It often ends up by being a party with TSC throwing in lunch for the workers.

Once you have established a level of competency you are able to make use of the club's sailing craft and a small fee is requested to help cover depreciation and maintenance and all the other costs. (broadly £5 per head).

Also, as a member you are able to hire the clubhouse for parties or other functions (ideal for a special birthday party perhaps). Please ask the Rear Commodore for full details.

For those locally based the lawn is an excellent place upon which to have a picnic with family or friends; any day of the week. There is no better riverside garden in Surbiton.

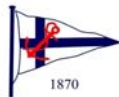

Application process:

- This form must be signed by the Applicant and the Applicant should request that Brian Johncey or a General Committee member also sign. (see notice board in clubhouse)
- The completed form must be returned to the Hon Secretary, Thames Sailing Club together with a cheque for the appropriate fee or advice of a Bank transfer, and date paid. (for bank details see over)
- The Applicant is then deemed to be a Temporary Member with all the rights and privileges open to a Temporary Member.
- The application form is displayed on the club notice-board for 2 weeks and is then presented at the next General Committee meeting.
- On the assumption that no objections are received the Applicant will be duly elected. The Membership Secretary will inform the Applicant that the application has been approved. In the extraordinary circumstance that the application is not approved the fees paid will be returned in full.

MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES



Thames Sailing Club

Family: Husband and wife, and established couples who are not married but cohabit, together with their children under the age of 18 - who shall be deemed Juniors - are eligible for family membership. All members of a family member unit can sail at all times and those over 18 can vote at Club General Meetings.

FULL: Individuals over the age of 18. Full members can sail at all times and can vote at Club General Meetings.

SOCIAL: Individuals over the age of 18. Social members are not barred from sailing at the Club but are not expected to sail more than four times a year. Social members cannot vote at Club General Meetings but can vote on committees.

ADULT STUDENT: Individuals over the age of 18 and under 25. Adult Student members can sail at all times. Adult Student members can vote at Club General Meetings.

JUNIOR: Individuals under the age of 18. Juniors require a 'responsible adult' to be on site at all times up until their 18th birthday. Junior members can sail at all times. Junior members cannot vote at Club General Meetings. (Note: A Junior is prescribed in Law as a person under the age of 18)

COUNTRY: A member over 18 years of age who lives more than 50 miles from the club. A Country member has no vote but may use all the club's facilities and sail on up to four occasions.

SUP (or Stand Up Paddle-boarder) member may make use of all the club's facilities at any time but may not vote on a committee or at any General Meeting.

Declaration by Applicant.

Disclosure: TSC takes your safety as of significant importance. Sailing can be safe and fun yet being involved with variable winds and water the unexpected is ever present. Each member is advised to discuss the fitness requirements necessary to enjoy water-sports on the river with Brian Johncey, a club member or officer. Members are requested to advise an officer should the member feel there is any reason why the member's abilities, mental or physical, may be limited under Health & Safety regulations. (This statement is included under the Duty of Care requirements for both members and TSC)

Club Rules: I have been advised of and accept the club Rules, Bye Laws and Policies which are displayed on the club Notice Board and available on the club website www.ThamesSailingClub.co.uk and have noted their contents. I also agree to participate in any work-party (or make a financial contribution) and to undertake any race duties or other duties that all members may be called upon to undertake. (Work-parties are usually for 2 hours in the spring and in the autumn: race duties usually are 2 or possibly 3 times per year for Sailing members, however Social members sometimes also enjoy assisting too.)
